Taking part as an Organisation



- Open to any public or private organisation worldwide
- Applications can be submitted by any eligible HEI worldwide
- HEIs in EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme: valid ECHE
- Other requirements: see Programme Guide

How does an EMJM look like?

Fixed Grant Agreement of 74 months independently from the length of the master

Commitment to enrol a certain number of students per project

At least 4 master editions lasting 1 to 2 academic years (60, 90,120 ECTS)

Start of the 1st edition no later than the academic year following the year of project selection

At least 2 study periods in 2 countries (of which at least one in an EU Member State or a third country associated to the Programme)

Geographical balance of students: no more than 10% of total scholarships per project awarded to students of the same nationality




Start with an Erasmus Mundus Design Measure and launch the basis for a joint programme

What is the rationale behind Erasmus Mundus Design Measure?

Encouraging the development of **new, innovative, high level integrated** transnational study programmes at Master level

Diversifying the offer of JM programmes and involve EM under represented EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and/or institutions from these countries, and/or thematic areas



Erasmus Mundus Action- calls for proposal 2022

- ✓ Publication of the Calls: 24 November 2021
- ✓ Opening of the Calls: **15 December 2021**
- ✓ Deadline: **16 February 2022**
- ✓ Expected date of selection results: **Summer 2022**
- ✓ Budget: 145M € (EMJM) ; 3M € (EMDM)
- ✓ Nr. of projects for EMJM: ~ 27
- ✓ Nr. of projects for EMDM: ~ 55



Main changes compared to call 2021

≻New terminology:

- Programme countries U Member States and Third countries associated to the Erasmus+
 Programme
- Partner countries hird countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme
- >Better definition of the award criteria
- Some clarifications in the wording
- EMJM: Duration of the Grant Agreement: now 74 months (instead of 6 academic years)
- EMJM: More top-up scholarships under Heading 6 per EMJM project: 3 under IPA III and 27 under NDICI for students from 9 target regions
- **EMJM: Regional priorities** under NDICI funds

Key messages from EM Calls 2021

Overall,,,,

- 2021 was a transition year with a **new programme, new action and new challenges**
- Positive feedback about the new concepts (EMJMs) and the new action (EMDMs)
- Although a new action, the number of Design Measures applications confirmed the need for preparatory measures
- Improvements needed in the application package

- ✓ Positive response to the new EMDM action -> 148 applications
- ✓ Attractive scheme at international level
 - ✓ applications from 40 different countries: **24** from EU Member States and third countries associated to the programme and **16** from other third countries
 - ➤41 applications from third countries not associated to the Programme (~ 28%)
 - Most represented third countries not associated to the programme: Russia, Ukraine, Georgia, Jordan, Morocco
- Confirmed interest from formerly under-represented EU Member
 States and third countries associated to the programme [applications from
 PL (6), LV (4), BG (3), HR (2), RO (2), CY (1), MK (1), Serbia (1) and SK (1)]

✓ Confirmed interest from completely new HEIs

- Out of 148 applicants, 62 brand NEW organisations (42%)
- 7 brand NEW organisations participating 2 times (KZ, LT, RU, TR, UA)

However these positive trends at application stage need to be confirmed in terms of results and for the second call

✓ Less applications compared to previous years due to the particular context


 \checkmark More diversification in the offer of EMJMs


Out of the 27 EMJMs proposed for funding, approx. 80% are new projects (21), 55 % are re-submissions (15)

✓ More internationalisation and opening to the world (1)

 For the first time, applications received from third countries not associated to the programme (India, Israel)

2021 EMJM Applications – Facts & Figures





+864 associated partners -> 320 institutions from third countries not associated to the Programme

* 31 third country HEIs not associated to the Programme

Average size per project: 16 associated and full partners

\checkmark More internationalisation and opening to the world (2)

- Not much changes in terms of countries of the coordinating institutions of the projects proposed for funding....
- ... however, for the first time, some new countries associated to the programme will coordinate an EMJM
- Projects proposed for funding:
 - 97 Full partners are involved from 36 Countries (23 EU Member States and third countries associated to the programme and 13 third countries not associated to the programme)
 - 357 associated partners from 68 countries of which around 70 % are third countries not associated to the programme

✓ Positive response to the EU external action policy:

- Out of the 70 applications, 60 requested NDICI funds and 50 IPA funds
- ✓ Higher commitment to award joint degrees
 - More than 50% of the applications foresees to award a joint degree either alone or in combination with a multiple of Double degrees
 - 36% plan to award only a joint degree

 Ambitious plans for the number of enrolled students and scholarships

- On average, applicants plan to enrol 125 students, i.e. 25 to 30 students per edition
- On average, 40 % of all enrolled students are non-scholarship holders
- 43% of EMJMs proposed for funding asked for the max. number of scholarships (60+24)
- ✓ More balanced representation in terms of origin of the scholarship holders
 - More than 41% of scholarships requested for students from EU Member states and third countries associated to the programme
